01 | Cloth Bags

02 | Book or Magazine Pages




Add a personal touch by using pages from a favourite story.

Excellent for larger gifts – use cartoon or sport sections for colour.



To minimize the amount used, make tightly creased folds when you wrap,


or tie the package up tightly with


reusable yarn or twine.
